

# The Sunny Pointe Elementary PTA Scholarship

## Guidelines

The Sunny Pointe Elementary PTA Scholarship shall be used to encourage students of the Blue Springs School District to further their education by attending an accredited college/university or trade/technical school. The scholarship will not be limited to any specific career selection or academic major. Each year, the Sunny Pointe Elementary PTA Scholarship Committee will be awarding one \$350.00 scholarship to a graduating senior in good standing enrolled in Blue Springs High School, Blue Springs South High School, or Valley View High School who attended Sunny Pointe Elementary School for two or more years. The Sunny Pointe Elementary PTA Scholarship will be awarded based upon scholastic achievement, student involvement, and community activities.

### Eligibility requirements:

1. Applicant must have attended Sunny Pointe Elementary for two years.
2. Applicant must be a member of their PTSA.
3. Student must have applied for admission to an accredited college/university or trade/technical school for the fall semester and must be planning to take a minimum of twelve (12) semester credit hours or its equivalent.
4. Applicant must be classified as a senior in good standing enrolled in Blue Springs High School, Blue Springs South High School or Valley View High School.

### How to apply for the Sunny Pointe Elementary PTA Scholarship:

Applicants should complete the application form and attach the following:

1. A copy (photocopy is acceptable) of the student's senior high school transcript and ACT/SAT test card
2. A copy of the student's current, signed, PTSA Card
3. One (1) Letter of Recommendation from a non-family member
4. An essay approximately 150 words describing the positive forces that have enabled you to succeed thus far and will sustain you into college

The completed Sunny Pointe Elementary PTA Scholarship application should be completed and returned to applicant's high school guidance office on or before April 1. The scholarship will be paid direct to the recipient once the student has given the Sunny Pointe Elementary Scholarship Chairperson proof of enrollment.

All information contained in this application will be held in strict confidence by the school and the scholarship screening committee.
