



WHAT IS BRAINS AND BREAKFAST?

Brains and Breakfast is a before-school tutoring program designed to improve student academic achievement through tutoring, homework help, test preparation, and help in completing past-due assignments. There are three teachers available to assist students as they work, and breakfast is served to all participants, free of charge.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE IN BRAINS AND BREAKFAST?

Students at every academic level currently participate in Brains and Breakfast; however, the program is specifically designed to help students who are currently failing one or more classes. If help is needed with classroom activities and homework, this is a perfect time for students to receive the help they need.

WHEN IS BRAINS AND BREAKFAST?

Brains and Breakfast takes place every Tuesday and Thursday on days when school is in session. Students may report to room 602/604 at 7:30 on those mornings and work with teachers until 8:00. Currently, Brains and Breakfast is only scheduled to take place through the 2011-2012 school year.

WHERE DOES BRAINS AND BREAKFAST TAKE PLACE?

Students participating in Brains and Breakfast meet two days a week in room 602/604. This is a large area that allows students to spread out, talk to teachers, and work quietly individually or in small groups without being interrupted by other students.
