Students in the Junior class pursuing education at highly selective colleges/universities

Kelly Bever's family along with the Blue Springs Education Foundation are seeking applications from the junior class at any of the three high schools: Blue Springs High School, Blue Springs South High School and Valley View High School. One recipient will be chosen to receive a scholarship that will reimburse up to \$300 of application fees to highly selective colleges and universities that also provide financial aid programs that meet full need with no loans. The following institutions meet the requirements: Brown, Caltech, Columbia, Cornell, Dartmouth, Harvard, MIT, Princeton, Stanford, University of Chicago, University of Pennsylvania and Yale. The college application process will be completed during the recipient's senior year in high school. Students will be honored and receive recognition at the Blue Springs Education Foundation reception in April. This scholarship is not renewable.

The scholarship will be awarded based on the following criteria:

- ❖ Students with an ACT score of **31 or above**
- ❖ Students with a cumulative GPA of **4.0 or above**
- ❖ Students who would qualify for a no-loan, full financial need aid program

The Blue Springs Education Foundation cover sheet must be included with the application.

by the **last Friday in February**.
