Jeff Wilcox was an exceptional leader and student at Blue Spring High School from 1985-1988. He was a straight A student, an Eagle Scout, and Senior Class President. Jeff always had tremendous relationships with his teachers and always went above and beyond what was expected of him. This was done in the spirit of being the best he could be in everything he did. Eventually, Jeff started his own business in technology, and was even written about in Wired magazine. Jeff passed away at the age of 35 from brain cancer, leaving a wife and two young boys behind.
