- 1.) **5th to 6th Grade Transition Summer Experience (5555)**: The goal of this experience is to introduce middle school concepts to students as a jumpstart to their middle school career. Students will focus on core curriculum concepts in Reading, English Language Arts and Math as well as enrichment projects focused on Science and Social Studies skills. Transition to middle school activities will include practice with lockers, rotational classes, exposure to middle school buildings, schedules, and an explanation of middle school expectations.

- 2.) **STEAM Academy (6786)**: This class will focus on Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math skills in practical real world experiences.
