BSHS Parking Guidelines

Parking at Blue Springs High School is a privilege. In order for students to drive to school and park, students must obtain a student parking sticker from the BSHS Admin Office. *The sticker must be visible on the front window*. The school district is not responsible for damage or accidents that occur to students' vehicles on school property. As per board policy 5.64, student vehicles parked on school grounds are subject to search when suspicion warrants such action.

Parking permits will be sold during registration & during the school year in the Admin Office. Parking permits will not be sold to students without proof of a valid driver's license.

STUDENT PARKING LOT ASSIGNMENT:

- ✓ No student parking in the Church lot directly across from the school
- ✓ No Student parking in the rear of the school where the staff lot is located

PARKING VIOLATION CONSEQUENCES

Parking in Unauthorized Locations:

A first offence the student will receive a warning ticket.

The second time a student violates parking they will receive either a \$25. Ticket or office referral or both.

Violations of city ordinances and towing of vehicles:

Autos parked in violation of city ordinance such as in handicap parking, a fire lane or adjacent to a fire hydrant are subject to a citation by the Blue Springs Police Department and or being towed at the owner's expense.

Autos parked in such a way as to impede the normal operation of school business will result in a citation and may be towed at the owner's expense. (i.e. Parked in a traffic lane, taking up more than one spot, blocking dumpsters or entrances).

If you have purchased a parking sticker, but it is not displayed **properly** on your vehicle you are subject to be ticketed.

If you drive a different vehicle other than the one registered, you MUST visit the Admin Office to register the vehicle.
