

## **BSSHS Student Parking Guidelines**

Parking at Blue Springs South High School is a privilege. In order for students to drive to school and park, students must obtain a student parking sticker from the BSSHS South Office. ***The sticker must be displayed clearly on the lower corner of the driver's side windshield. The school district is not responsible for damage or accidents that occur to students' vehicles on school property.*** As per board policy 5.64, student vehicles parked on school grounds are subject to search when suspicion warrants such action. Student parking in the Young Park area (north side of BSSHS) by special permit and only includes the main parking area by the ball fields. Students are subject to the same rules and policies per Board Policy 5.64. **Areas reserved for staff parking are marked with a blue curb. Vehicles parked on a blue curb which is reserved for staff will be ticketed accordingly.**

Parking decals are color-coded to specific parking lots – not to curbs. Students must park in the lots assigned by the color of the decals. Blue \$30 (SENIORS) - Green \$25 (Juniors & Sophomores) - Silver lot \$30 (Band & Orchestra students with approval from Music Directors)

Replacement permits will cost the full price of the permit.

Parking permits will be sold during registration & during the school year in the South Office. Parking permits will not be sold to students without proof of a valid driver's license.

### **STUDENT PARKING LOT ASSIGNMENT:**

- **No student parking in the PAC (Lot 2).**
- Young Park baseball/softball (Lot 1): SILVER PARKING DECALS ONLY
- South (Lots 4 & 5) & East (Lot 3): BLUE PARKING DECALS ONLY
- Lower stadium parking (Lot 6): GREEN PARKING DECALS ONLY
- **PARKING AREAS WITH BLUE CURBS ARE RESERVED FOR STAFF**

### **PARKING VIOLATION CONSEQUENCES**

#### Parking in Unauthorized Locations:

Fines will be issued for the value of the permit price for the respective location (i.e. blue lot fines would be \$30). Multiple fines may result in a consequence that may extend into the next school year.

Violations of city ordinances and towing of vehicles:

Autos parked in violation of city ordinance such as in handicap parking, a fire lane or adjacent to a fire hydrant are subject to a citation by the Blue Springs Police Department and or being towed at the owner's expense.

Autos parked in such a way as to impede the normal operation of school business will result in a citation and may be towed at the owner's expense. (i.e. Parked in a traffic lane, taking up more than one spot, blocking dumpsters or entrances).

*If you have purchased a parking sticker, but it is not displayed **properly** on your vehicle you are subject to be ticketed.*

**If you drive a different vehicle other than the one registered, you MUST visit the South Office to register the vehicle. If you do not sign in on the clipboard, you are subject to be ticketed. Information needed: your name, vehicle type and license plate number.**
